The Namibia Economist has organised and hosted the Namibian Businesswoman Awards since 1997. Award Categories are as follows:

- **Business Owner Award**

Open to: Owners with a 50% share or more in a business with responsibility for key management decision-making.

- **Private and Corporate Sector Award**

Open to: Employees in the private and corporate sectors, or owners with less than a 50% share of a business.

- **Community and Government Award**

Open to: Employees of government departments, statutory bodies and not-for-profit organizations.

- **Young Business Women's Award**

Open to: All entrants in one of the categories listed above who will be aged 30 years or under as at 5 June 2019.

Category winners - Each winner goes on to become a finalist in the National Awards ceremony. In this ceremony, the Namibian Businesswoman of the Year is announced.
