Invitation to Public Consultation: Statutory Protection of the Broiler Industry

This serves as an official notification to the public, the Minister of Industrialisation, Trade and SME Development (MITSMED) has decided to review the current statutory protection of the broiler industry.

More than six (6) years has lapsed since the implementation of the import quota measure in April 2013. There has been far reaching changes in the global, regional and national economic landscape affecting the poultry industry and has necessitated the need to review the current measure.

The Minister of MITSMED, therefore, deems it appropriate to review and consider the current measure, as well as alternative options, aimed at supporting and nurturing sustainable broiler industry in Namibia.

MITSMED will host a broad public consultative engagement to discuss and recommend suitable measure to safeguard the industry. All interested parties are invited to the consultation meeting that will take place on Friday, 13th September 2019 at 09h00. The venue will be communicated in due course.
