

## INVITATION TO SUBMIT PROJECT PROPOSALS

The Meat Board of Namibia (MBN), an organization established in terms of the Meat Industry Act, 1981 (Act No. 12 of 1981) (the “Act”), as amended has the mission to promote a conducive environment for sustainable meat production, market growth and diversification of livestock, meat and meat products.

The MBN intends to render assistance to organisations desiring to promote the improvement, production, preservation, slaughter, preparation, processing, storing, consumption or marketing of livestock, meat and meat products of species cattle, sheep, goats and pigs or anything derived therefrom in order to achieve the objectives of the Act.

Projects should amongst others:

1. Accentuate the strategic goals of the MBN Strategic Plan;
2. Serve an extensive segment(s) of beneficiaries;
3. Be replicated to other regions;
4. Clearly demonstrate sound business principles (e.g. ROI);
5. Significantly contribute to the financial (N\$) growth of the meat industry and agricultural Gross Domestic Product;

Project proposals should be accompanied by certified copies of the following documents:

- Legal status of the entity (registration documents);
- Good Standing documents from the Receiver of Revenue;
- Good Standing documents from the Social Security Commission;
- Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate;
- Proof of Namibia bank account.
