



## Public Accountants’ and Auditors’ Board

### **Invitation for written submissions on the draft Accountants’ and Auditors’ Bill 2019**

The PAAB is established by the Public Accountants’ and Auditors’ Act (PAAA) No 51 of 1951 (as amended) with the mandate to regulate Public Accountants and Auditors in Namibia. In its effort to improve and enhance its regulatory role, the PAAB embarked upon a process of drafting a new Accountants and Auditors (AA) Bill which seeks to repeal the PAAA No. 51 of 1951 (as amended). Among others the Bill introduces comprehensive regulation of the accountancy profession to include auditors, general accountants and tax practitioners offering services to the public for a fee.

All stakeholders are therefore invited to provide written submissions on the draft AA Bill.

Once all written submissions are received, a stakeholders’ workshop will be convened to discuss the draft Bill before a final draft is submitted to the Minister of Finance.
