



PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS' AND AUDITORS' BOARD DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE OF THE PAAB CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The Public Accountants' and Auditors' Board (PAAB) is a statutory body established in terms of Section 2 of the Public Accountants and Auditors (PAA) Act, No. 51 of 1951, (as amended). As part of its mandate of statutory oversight of public accountants and auditors in Namibia, the PAAB investigates allegations of improper conduct against registered auditors including conducting disciplinary hearings. Accordingly, in terms of Sections 10 & 27 of the PAA Act, the PAAB has established a Disciplinary Committee (DISCOM), which is a committee of the PAAB, tasked with determining charges of improper conduct against registered auditors, and imposing appropriate sanctions.

The Terms of Reference (TOR) of the Disciplinary Committee require that the Disciplinary Committee must be chaired by a retired judge/senior advocate or legal practitioner with more than 10 years practising experience and must consist of:

- At least two retired judges or senior advocates / legal practitioner with at least 10 years' experience in practising law;
- persons with at least 10 years' experience in auditing who were **formerly registered** as External auditors
- other suitably qualified persons as determined by the PAAB.

The PAAB is inviting applications for 9 members of DISCOM based on their expertise, experience and interest in the field of Law, Auditing, Accounting and Ethics.

Disciplinary Committee members currently serve a term of three years, renewable twice at the discretion of the PAAB Board up to a maximum of 9 years.

In appointing suitable persons, the PAAB will take into account the current demographic composition of the committees and will seek to achieve a more representative committee in accordance with the demographics of the country.

Eligible persons who wish to be considered for appointment are invited to submit applications to the Head of Secretariat on: hr@paab.com.na or P.O. Box 11913, Windhoek Applications must include a cover letter and a Curriculum Vitae detailing the applicant's knowledge, experience and suitability as a DISCOM member.

Shortlisted candidates may be called for an interview. The closing date for applications is 31 May 2022.
