The Electricity Control Board (ECB) is a statutory electricity regulator established by the Electricity Act, 2000 (Act No. 2 of 2000) which Act was repealed by the Electricity Act 2007 (Act. No. 4 of 2007). The ECB's mandate is to exercise control over the electricity supply industry (ESI) and to regulate the generation, transmission, distribution, supply, use, import and export of electricity in Namibia in accordance with the prevailing government policy so as to ensure order in the efficient supply of electricity.
